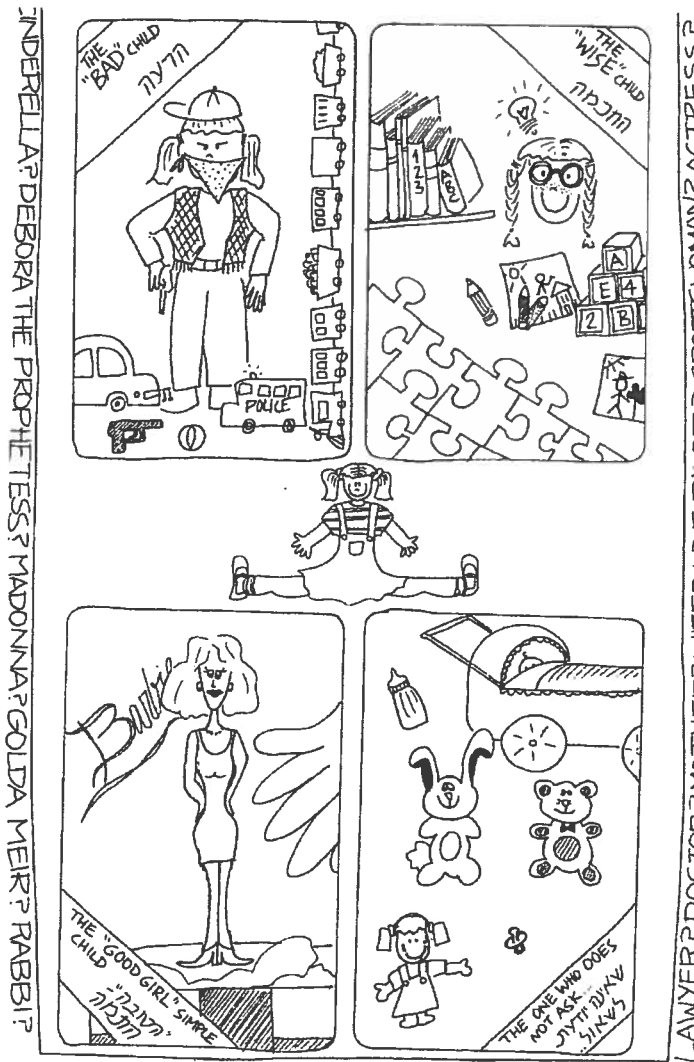


# Passover Text for Younger Children

1. Why do you think the “wise child” is drawn with puzzles and books? What else could be added to that picture?
2. Why is the “bad child” drawn with a train and cars? If she could ask a question about Passover, what would she ask?
3. Why is the “good child/simple child” drawn as a doll? Can a doll think and ask questions?
4. Why is the “child who cannot ask” a baby? What do we need to teach the baby about Passover?
